Spaying and neutering reduce roaming and unwanted litters that often lead to pets entering shelters.

Spaying and neutering are key preventative services that help prevent uterine infections, testicular cancer, and costly future surgeries.

Unfixed animals can't be around others, and we don't have staff for extra walks or playtime. Being kenneled 23 hours a day isn't healthy for them.

We don't have fosters for unfixed pets, as most don't want animals in heat or marking.

Ruff Haven provides hundreds of dollars in free preventative care like vaccines, dewormer, and medication to keep your pet healthy.
